

ALTON BUS RALLY & RUNNING DAY

Anstey Park, Anstey Lane, Alton, Hampshire, GU34 2NB

Directions to Alton

Sat Nav: Anstey Park postcode is GU34 2NB.

From London, the M25 and the East (using the A3 heading South)

Follow A3 (crossing the M25 at M25 Junction 10) out of London to Guildford, then join the A31 to Alton via Farnham. As you approach Alton on the A31 take the 2nd exit (right) at the roundabout, signposted: Alton B3004. **(Then see 'From A31 to Anstey Park' overleaf).**

From the M3 (using the A331 heading South)

Exit M3 at Junction 4 (Frimley) onto the A331 to Farnham. At the end of the A331 join the A31 to Alton. As you approach Alton on the A31 take the 2nd exit (right) at the roundabout, signposted: Alton B3004. **(Then see 'From A31 to Anstey Park' overleaf).**

From the A303 (the South West), M4 (the West) and M40 (the Midlands) via Winchester (using the A34 heading South)

At the end of the A34, where it meets the M3 at Junction 9 (Winchester), follow signs to join A31 towards Alton. As you approach Alton on the A31 the A32 will join from the right at Chawton roundabout. Take the 2nd exit at this roundabout, signposted: Alton, Farnham, Guildford A31. Continue on the A31 along the Alton bypass towards Farnham. At the next roundabout take the 1st exit, signposted: Alton B3004. **(Then see 'From A31 to Anstey Park' overleaf).**

From Basingstoke (using the A339 heading South)

Take the A339 towards Alton. As you approach Alton turn right into Pertuis Avenue / Whitedown Lane (still the A339), signposted: Town Centre, Superstore, Alton, Other Routes. At the end of Whitedown Lane go under Butts bridge and take 1st turning (left) at mini roundabout, signposted: Town Centre. Go under other span of Butts bridge. **(Then see 'From The Butts to Anstey Park' overleaf).**

From Southampton and Dorset via Winchester (using the M3 heading North East)

Exit M3 at Junction 10 (Winchester) and follow signs to join A31 towards Alton. As you approach Alton on the A31 the A32 will join from the right at Chawton roundabout. Take the 2nd exit at this roundabout, signposted: Alton, Farnham, Guildford A31. Continue on the A31 along the Alton bypass towards Farnham. At the next roundabout take the 1st exit, signposted: Alton B3004. **(Then see 'From A31 to Anstey Park' overleaf).**

From Fareham, Portsmouth and the South (using the A32 heading North)

Follow A32 from Fareham until it meets the A31 at Chawton roundabout just outside Alton. Take the 3rd exit at this roundabout, signposted: Alton, Farnham, Guildford A31. Continue on the A31 along the Alton bypass towards Farnham. At the next roundabout take the 1st exit, signposted: Alton B3004. **(Then see 'From A31 to Anstey Park' overleaf).**

From Portsmouth and the South via Petersfield (using the A3 heading North)

Follow A3(M) then A3 to Petersfield and join the A272 westbound towards Winchester. At West Meon Hut crossroads turn right onto the A32 towards Alton. Follow A32 until it meets the A31 at Chawton roundabout just outside Alton. Take the 3rd exit at this roundabout, signposted: Alton, Farnham, Guildford A31. Continue on the A31 along the Alton bypass towards Farnham. At the next roundabout take the 1st exit, signposted: Alton B3004. **(Then see 'From A31 to Anstey Park' overleaf).**

Once in Alton follow the yellow Bus Rally signs to the rally site at Anstey Park

Directions to Anstey Park

Once in Alton follow the yellow Bus Rally signs to the rally site at Anstey Park

From A31 to Anstey Park

The rally site is approximately 1 mile from the A31 roundabout. Continue along road from A31 roundabout, into ALTON and into 30mph zone. Go straight ahead at traffic light crossroads. After you pass the Queens Head pub on your right the rally site will be on your right. Go past the rally site and turn next right into Anstey Lane, signposted: Wooteys Infant & Junior Schools, Alton School, St. John Ambulance. Then turn next right into Anstey Park.

From The Butts to Anstey Park

The rally site is approximately 1¾ miles from Butts bridge. Continue along road from Butts bridge and at junction for High Street, follow road round to the right into Draymans Way (M&S on corner). Go straight ahead at mini roundabout and over pelican crossing (Sainsbury's on RHS). Go straight ahead at next mini roundabout. At next mini roundabout turn right into Normandy Street, signposted: All other routes. After approximately ¾ mile turn left into Anstey Lane, signposted: Wooteys Infant & Junior Schools, Alton School, St. John Ambulance. Then turn next right into Anstey Park.

Anstey Park



A one-way system will operate within Anstey Park.
Entry to Anstey Park will be from Anstey Lane only.
Exit from Anstey Park will be to Anstey Road only.



Speed limit in Anstey Park is 10 mph.
This applies to all vehicles in all parts of Anstey Park and includes the tarmac surfaced roads within Anstey Park.



Be aware of pedestrians whilst driving in Anstey Park.

Car park open 9am to 6pm.

Information for drivers of large vehicles

Filling stations accessible to large vehicles

Always check vehicle height and canopy height before driving under the canopy.

Farnham

BP, A31 Farnham bypass (Westbound), 11 miles from Alton. Canopy height: 4.5m.

Esso, A31 Hog's Back (Eastbound), access to A31 and A331, 13 miles from Alton. Canopy height: 5.1m.

Ropley

Shell, A31, 9 miles from Alton. Canopy height: 4.2m*.

*HGV pump nearest road is outside canopy but HGV pump furthest from road is under canopy.

West Meon Hut

BP, A32 / A272 crossroads, 11 miles from Alton. Canopy height: 4.5m.
